

Glenfield Borough Council Meeting

June 1, 2026

The Glenfield Borough Council Meeting was brought to order by President Carmody at 5:00 p.m. with the salute to the flag. Roll was called and present were Paul Carmody, Gayle Davis, Joel Kaminski, Curtis Reiner, Megan Larkin, Michael Seymour and Connie Klauck.

Visitors: Aaron Pollock, Sarah Plachecki (QVSB Members)

Mr. Pollock, President of the Quaker Valley Softball and Baseball board, introduced himself to Council and stated that the new QVSB would like to be a part of the communities they play in. They recently did a fund-raising event and are putting money into the fields that they use to improve them. They would like to develop a partnership with Glenfield, hopefully through an agreement drawn up by Mr. Seymour, to provide a division of labor with caring for the baseball field at Riverside Park.

Sarah Plachecki, Secretary of the QVSB, got contact information for Glenfield representatives. She explained that the QVSB board meets monthly with an Agenda. They are striving for better communication through their Newsletter, website and a larger Social Media presence. Various Council members asked them questions. Mayor Larkin explained that Glenfield should be listed as an additional Insured on QVRA's insurance policy. She also asked if they would be looking to make another field at the park. Mr. Kaminski asked what kind of field improvements they want to make at the Park. Mr. Carmody thanked them for attending the Council Meeting.

Reading and Approval of Bills: Ms. Klauck read aloud the bills for May 2026 while the members of Council followed along. A MOTION was made by Ms. Davis; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to pay the May bills. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

Fire Report: Mr. Carmody reported that there were 41 calls in May and that 1 of them was in Glenfield on I 79.
