

Glenfield Borough Reorganization Meeting

January 5, 2026

Magistrate Giuseppe Roselli administered the Oath of Office to Council Members Gayle Davis, Jaimee Hoffman, Joel Kaminski, Ryan Paulus and Curtis Reiner along with Tax Collector Chris Leonberg.

Mr. Carmody called for nominations for Temporary Chair to run the Reorganization Meeting, due to the absence of Mayor Larkin. A Motion was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to nominate Paul Carmody as Temporary Chair. The Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Carmody call the Glenfield Borough Reorganization Meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. with the salute to the flag. Roll was called and present were Paul Carmody, Gayle Davis, Jaimee Hoffman, Joel Kaminski, Ryan Paulus, Curtis Reiner, Solicitor Michael Seymour and Secretary Connie Klauck.

Mr. Carmody asked for a MOTION to open nominations for the position of Council President. A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner to open nominations for President of Council. The Motion carried unanimously. Mr. Reiner nominated Paul Carmody. A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski to close nominations; unanimously passed. Mr. Carmody was unanimously elected as President of Council.

Mr. Carmody asked for a MOTION to open nominations for the position of Council Vice-President. A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski to open nominations for Vice President of Council. The Motion carried unanimously. Mr. Kaminski nominated Mr. Reiner. A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski to close nominations; unanimously passed. Mr. Reiner was unanimously elected as Vice-President of Council.

Mr. Carmody took over gavel as President of Council.

APPOINTMENT OF BOROUGH OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski; seconded by Mr. Reiner; to appoint the law offices of Michael D. Seymour as the Borough Solicitor. No discussion held; all were in favor - Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski; seconded by Mr. Reiner; to appoint Harshman Civil Engineering Group as the Borough's Engineering firm. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski; seconded by Mr. Reiner; to reappoint Building Inspection Underwriters as the Building Inspector / Zoning Officer under the current terms and conditions of their contract. The contract is still month to month. All were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to appoint Keystone Tax Services as the Tax Collector for Earned Income tax. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to enter into a 3-year contract with and appoint Keystone Tax Services as the Tax Collector for Local Services Tax. Solicitor Seymour explained to Council that the LST is a \$10.00/year tax for working in the Borough and that, according to an ordinance from 1969, the tax collector is whomever Council designates. All were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to appoint Travis Hartzog to the vacant Council seat for a 2-year term. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

APPOINTMENTS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

A MOTION was made by Mr. Paulus; seconded by Mr. Reiner; to appoint Gayle Davis as the primary delegate and Joel Kaminski as the alternate delegate to the Quaker Valley Council of Governments. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to appoint Joel Kaminski as President Pro Tempore of Council. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Kaminski; seconded by Mr. Reiner; reappoint Kevin Klauck to the Zoning Hearing Board for a 3-year term, ending 12/31/2028. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to reappoint Gayle Davis to the Planning Commission for a 4-year term, ending 12/31/2029. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Ms. Davis; seconded by Mrs. Hoffman; to appoint Lauren Life to the Planning Commission for a 4-year term, ending 12/31/2029. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Paulus; seconded by Mr. Reiner; to appoint Amanda Frank to the IPMC Appeals Board for a 3-year term, ending 12/31/2028. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

OTHER BUSINESS

There was no Other Business.
