

# Glenfield Borough Council Meeting

**November 17, 2025**

The Glenfield Borough Council Meeting was brought to order by President Paul Carmody at 7:00 p.m. with the salute to the flag. Roll was called and present were Paul Carmody, Joel Kaminski, Ryan Paulus, Travis Hartzog, Curtis Reiner, Michael Seymour and Connie Klauck.

**Visitors:** Jason and Jaimee Hoffman

Jaimee Hoffman attended the meeting because she believes that she was elected to Council via write in. Council thanked her for coming and told her to be sure to return the paper work she receives from Allegheny County to officially claim her seat.

**Minutes:** The minutes from the October 20, 2025 Council Meeting were reviewed. A Motion was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to accept the minutes. No discussion held; all were in favor – motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Ms. Klauck read aloud the Treasurer's Report from October 2025 to Council. A Motion was made by Mr. Paulus; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to approve the report. No discussion held; all were in favor – motion passed.

**Wage and Real Estate Tax:** For the month of October 2025, \$859.54 was collected for Wage Tax and \$0.00 for Real Estate Tax.

**Reading and Approval of Bills:** Connie Klauck read aloud the bills for October 2025 while the members of Council followed along. A Motion was made by Mr. Kaminski; seconded by Mr. Hartzog; to pay the October bills. No discussion held; 4 in favor – Paul Carmody abstained. Motion passed.

**Police Report:** There was no Police Report.

**Fire Report:** There was no Fire Report.

**Solicitor's Report:** Solicitor Seymour reminded Council that the Reorganization Meeting in January will take place on January 5, 2026. Due to the Mayor elect Megan Larkin being out of town, Council will need to arrange for Magistrate Rosselli to swear the newly elected officials in. Ms. Klauck will call to schedule.

**Correspondence:** After discussion, Council decided to hold the 2026 Council Meetings on the first Monday of the month at 5:00 p.m. A Motion to advertise the meeting schedule will be done at the December Council Meeting.

**Budget and Finance Committee:** Ms. Klauck reviewed the 2026 Budget with Council again, answering any questions. A Motion to approve / adopt the Budget will be done at the December Meeting.

**Grants Committee:** President Carmody spoke with Valerie Gaydos and was informed that recipients should be notified tomorrow if their grant applications were granted. He said that he will inform Council if he hears the status of the paving grant application they submitted.

**Public Safety:** Mr. Reiner reported that some areas of the streets seem very dark and that he would like to look into possibly adding some street lights. He will reach out to Duquesne Light to get pricing. Mr. Paulus asked him to have Duquesne Light inspect some of the poles because he feels they are in disrepair.

**COG:** President Carmody reported that a new Public Relations person, Jeremy Shoemaker, from Norfolk Southern attended the meeting. Mr. Carmody shared the contact information with Council. Mr. Shoemaker informed all that Norfolk Southern has grants available for Municipalities.

**Building and Ordinance:** None.

**Streets and Sewers:** Mr. Reiner would like to try to schedule the SHACOG VAC truck to clean the catch basins especially on East Beaver. Ms. Klauck will see if it is available.

Mr. Paulus reported that the yield sign getting onto the 79 South ramp from Deer Run is missing and causing problems. Mr. Reiner will send the information on how to create a work order with PennDOT to Mr. Paulus.

**Parks and Recreation:** Mr. Reiner reported that they are planning on holding the Holiday Lights contest this year and that they are working out the details still.

**Old Business:** There was no Old Business.

**New Business:** There was no New Business.

**Adjournment:** A Motion was made by Mr. Paulus; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to adjourn the Council Meeting. No discussion held; all were in favor – motion passed. The Council Meeting was adjourned at 7:56 p.m.
