

Glenfield Borough Council Meeting

May 4, 2026

The Glenfield Borough Council Meeting was brought to order by President Paul Carmody at 5:00 p.m. with the salute to the flag. Roll was called and present were Paul Carmody, Gayle Davis, Joel Kaminski, Ryan Paulus, Curtis Reiner, Michael Seymour and Connie Klauck.

Visitors: Ryan Gilmore, Kristine Leonberg

Minutes: The minutes from the April 6, 2026 Regular Council Meeting were reviewed. A MOTION was made by Mr. Paulus; seconded by Mr. Reiner; to accept the minutes. No discussion held; all were in favor – motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Ms. Klauck read aloud the Treasurer's Report for March 2026. A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to approve the March 2026 report. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

Wage and Real Estate Tax: For the month of April 2026, \$5,055.33 was collected for Wage Tax and \$6,885.00 for Real Estate and Per Capita Tax.

Reading and Approval of Bills: Ms. Klauck read aloud the bills for March 2026 while the members of Council followed along. A MOTION was made by Ms. Davis; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to pay the April bills. Mr. Carmody asked for details on the Pennsylvania One Call bill and Council decided to pay the April bills, with the exception of the Pennsylvania One Call. That will be paid next month if charges are accurate. All were in favor – Motion passed.

Police Report: There was no Police Report.

Fire Report: Ryan Gilmore reported that they responded to 34 calls in April 2026 and that 2 of them were accidents on Route 65 in Glenfield Borough.

Solicitor's Report: Solicitor Seymour had no report.

Correspondence: Ms. Klauck reported that the information for the 2025 Annual Financial Audit has been submitted to the Auditors, Mercadante & Company.

Budget and Finance Committee: None.

Public Safety: A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to nominate Justin Gilmore as the Emergency Management Coordinator and to authorize taking the steps required to support the nomination, including sending correspondence verifying the nomination. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

Building and Ordinance: None.

Streets and Sewers: Mr. Reiner received another complaint about the mud/soot buildup along East Beaver Street. He would like to have the street cleaned.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Paulus; seconded by Mr. Kaminski; to get a quote from Boyd Construction for the road's gutter cleanup, and approve work not to exceed \$5000.00. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to approve Robinson Pipe Cleaning Company cleaning the catch basins and camera the sewers along East Beaver, at \$450.00/hour, not to exceed \$7000.00. No discussion held; all were in favor – Motion passed.

Parks and Recreation: Mr. Kaminski reported that the Quaker Valley Recreation Association would like to do some field improvements to the baseball field at Riverside Park.

Mayor's Report: Due to Mayor Larkin's absence, there was no report.

Old Business: There was no Old Business.

New Business: There was no New Business.

Adjournment: A MOTION was made by Mr. Reiner; seconded by Mr. Paulus; to adjourn the Council Meeting. No discussion held; all were in favor. Meeting adjourned at 5:46 p.m.
